

# Moonscape

## in CorelDraw

1. Start a new document (blank).
2. Make the background black.
3. Make a large rectangle with grey fill for the foreground.
4. Make a blob with a grey gradient fill.
5. Duplicate the blob several times (Ctrl+D), moving and resizing it.
6. Create a horizontal skinny ellipse for the blob shadows; duplicate as required.
7. Earth is a circle with a texture fill (Styles, Water 5 colors).
8. The sun is a circle with a radial fountain fill, from black to yellow, Edge Pad 14%, Mid-point 44% (click Edit on the Fill tab).
9. The other stars are duplicates of the sun, really small.
